We have two exciting global journeys in the pipeline—the Farming, Scenic & Hosted journey in November which is being hosted by six of our clubs, and I am about to advertise a new global journey called "Great Bike Trails of New Zealand" planned for February next year. That journey will be for e-bike enthusiasts from around the world and will be hosted by Hamilton-Waikato, Kapiti and Wellington, after which the ambassadors will travel to the South Island to do the Cromwell and Otago Rail Trails (including two days sightseeing with Pete Higginbottom). So it looks like an exciting adventure that we are offering, and I am hoping this will attract the next generation of Friendship Force members.

Outbound Journeys for 2024

We have received our allocated outbound journeys for 2024. Although these have been assigned to particular clubs, they are intended to be NZ-wide journeys and will be open to any member to apply to join. The journeys are:

- ⇒ Isle of Wight, UK, May 2024—assigned to Northland and Wairarapa Clubs
- \Rightarrow Cairo, Egypt, October 2024—assigned to Christchurch and Hamilton-Waikato Clubs
- ⇒ Greater Hamilton & Burlington and Haliburton Highlands, Canada, September 2024—assigned to Wellington Club
- ⇒ North Moreton and Tamworth, Australia, September/October 2024—assigned to Kapiti Coast Club.

Once these journeys have been confirmed and ambassador coordinators have been appointed we will let you know who to contact. They do look like exciting destinations!

Individual Journeys

This new programme gives members more opportunities to form friendships with inbound or outbound small groups and even individuals. It is an extension of the present 'Club to Club' Journeys that have formed the basis for FFI Journeys in the past.

To make this programme work, FFI needs members to register as hosts. Those who have registered for <u>my.friendshipforce.org</u> will have recently received a post (like below) that includes a link to further information about the programme including questions you may have.

To make this programme work, FFI needs hosts. Please take these steps:

- 1. To participate, you must join <u>my.friendshipforce.org</u>.
- 2. Type into your browser <u>my.friendshipforce.org</u>, and open this using your user name and password. This will bring you to the FFI website where there is a section about 'Individual Journeys'.
- 3. Open the 'read more' button and click on 'the individual hosting opportunities' which will take you direct to the host registration form.
- 4. Complete the form (takes 5-10 minutes), and you will be up and running. Note: You would only be assigned one hosting unless you renew your invitation.

Of course for this scheme to work we also need ambassadors to sign up to take advantage of these hostings! If you are planning to travel somewhere in the world in the next year or so, check out to see if there are hosts in the cities you are visiting who might be willing to host you.

Costs – These are in the vicinity of <u>NZ\$1,500</u> for overnight in Vancouver (optional) plus 13 nights being home-hosted. For accommodation and land travel six nights 20th-25th September allow <u>NZ\$1,200 upwards.</u>

Travel & Arrival: You will need to pay for your own airfares *Auckland to Winnipeg; Winnipeg to Toronto;* and *Toronto to Auckland* approx. <u>NZ\$3,000 if you</u> <u>book by April/May</u>. Plan to arrive Winnipeg Airport on 13th September by about 2pm.

Notes:

- The host clubs require Ambassadors to be fully vaccinated and boosted for Covid 19.
- You will be required to have full travel insurance.
